The circulating collection also includes magazines, puzzles and books on tape for adults and children.

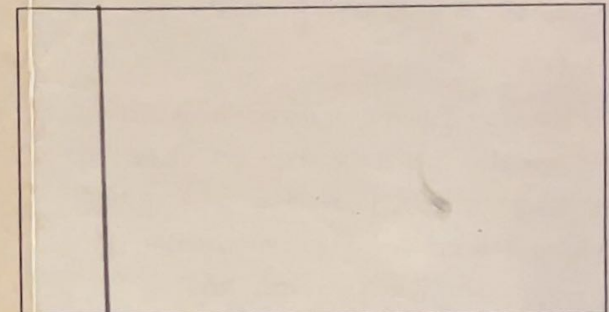

## Mission Statement

The Hanover Town Library will be an active presence in the village, providing services to the community in a personal manner while preserving its historic building.

## History

The Hanover Town Library began as a lending collection at the general store in the village in 1899. In 1905 the present building was erected on land donated by the Hayes family, whose farm still surrounds the building.

## Governance and Funding

The Hanover Town Library is governed by a three member Board of Trustees. Trustees are elected for three year terms by the citizens of Hanover. The library is funded by the Town of Hanover and also supported by charitable contributions.

## Lending Procedure

Items from the library may be checked out with your Libraries of Hanover, NH card.

There are no fines for late returns.

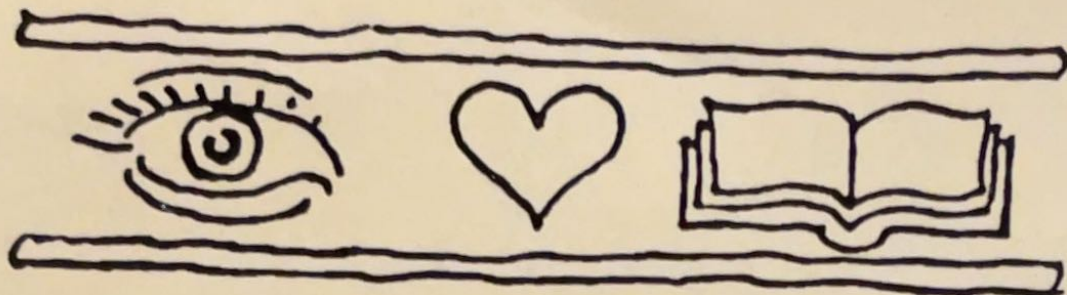
## Gifts
