

Spiderweb Craft

1. Tie the end of the string without tape to one of the holes on the paper plate.
2. String yarn back and forth through the holes, in whatever order children want. *
3. Add the little spider ring to the web, once you're finished.
4. Hang it in a window or somewhere else you'd like, to enjoy.

**This activity can be modified for very young children in the following ways: The string can be shortened, and/or children can go through less holes to make their web. Another way to modify for younger children would be to make notches on the outside of the plate, for children to wrap around the plate, instead of going through individual holes.*
