#### **Old Business**

- Rotating Video Game Collection: 100 new bags: 90 already have been borrowed.
- Volunteer Events: 11-1 Pm July 19th, new and current volunteers to unite to be celebrated and learn about new volunteer opportunities.
- Gazebo: Much planning and work by Jeff with communication with town planners Jennifer and Alex.

### o Key points:

- Planning Application was completed by Jeff and submitted to the Town Planning Group (Jennifer and Alex).
- The Gazebo only requires a gravel stone base (no concrete), and the architectural plan needs to be corrected to reflect this.
  - John (our trustee) will meet with Paul (architect) to initiate edits to the plan to remove reference to the need for cement.
- There is a timeline concern for Gazebo delivery in relation to plan approval and site work.
  - The Carriage Shed can hold on delivery if needed.
- Jeff and Etna Library Trustees will attend a meeting with the Town of Hanover Planners for a minor project approval discussion on July 22 at 1:30.

#### **New Business:**

- Library signage for Hours of Operation and for upcoming events, discussion for upgrades and options of design and placement were considered. More input is needed; we will be surveying the volunteers on July 19 for additional input.
- Current event signage needs to be updated to stay current, exploring a volunteer effort to keep this signage current.
- Reading Garden additions, ring toss games and water activity station,
  - o Upgrade of outdoor furniture for the reading garden needs to be explored
- Summer Reading, ongoing; about 90 bags have been given out, animal/critter activity going well.
- Dog library has been up and running and going well, many wagging tails and participants.
