Lands are commonly granted upon in this his Province
your Petitioners now standing ready to enter upon

possible, full fill & perform every Article of their Grant
and as in Duty Borne they will ever Pray

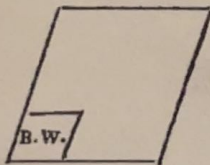
