Librarian's Report – Library visits have increased 20 percent from last year. Circulation of books and audios is up.

Old Business

Programs – This month's programs were well attended including book group, two knitting programs, children's mod podge craft.

May Trustee Election – Two candidates will run for the open position.

Etna Library coffee mugs – At a minimum of 36 mugs, each mug would cost \$6.50. They are being considered as possible gifts for volunteers and for sale.

Library cards – discussed text on cards and whether we should order just cards or key tags also.

Library coverage is very good including when Barbara will be away.

Pollinator garden will be planted by Hanover Garden Club member Susan Weeks. The garden will include native plants that attract bees and butterflies.

Two part *Hanover's Historic Wolfeboro Road* program on May 6th and 13th is a joint project of the Hanover Conservancy, Hanover Historical Society, the Howe Library and the Etna Library. The Etna Library will provide cookies for the May 13th hike.
