Dear Friend of Etna Library,

The library has been a buzz of excitement and activity this winter. The foundation has been poured and the timber frame and walls are soon to be put in place for the handicapped accessible Etna Library addition. The parking lot and walks are prepared and ready to be paved. The landscaping will also be completed once warm weather arrives and the bulk of the construction work is complete.

The budget that we initially set for this project will cover the expenses of the exterior of the building and a basic level of interior finish, but the Library trustees and staff have worked with the project architect to add some special touches that will result in an addition that truly complements the historic beauty of the original library. Our goal is to raise an additional \$15,000 in the next few months. This money will allow for the use of plaster finish in the building, will provide for significantly upgraded and architecturally appropriate lighting fixtures, and will provide for an upgraded quality of interior finish details.
