

BASIL

Ocimum spp.

LIFE CYCLE: Annual.

CULTURE: *Direct seed* – Seed germinates best at 55–70°F/18–21°C. Plant seeds ¼" deep, 2–3 seeds per inch, in rows 18" apart. Firm the soil over the seeds. Thinning is not necessary, but 4–8" final spacing produces healthy, full plants. *Transplant* – Sow indoors 6 weeks prior to setting out. Plant ¼" deep and keep at 70°F/21°C for best germination. Transplant to field when seedlings have 3–4 sets of leaves. Final spacing 4–8" for transplants, in rows 18" apart. **Note:** Holy Basil requires some light for germination, so sow more shallowly than other basil.

PELLETED SEED: Use pelleted seed within 6 months of purchase.

GERMINATION: 5–10 days.

LIGHT/SOIL REQUIREMENTS: Moderately rich, moist soil and full sun. Basil is not drought tolerant and can be damaged by heat stress. Regular moisture throughout the growing season helps to ensure a good crop.

HEIGHT: 8–30" depending on variety.

HARVEST: Begin light harvesting after plants have become established. It is best done in the early morning when the temperature is cooler and the leaves are less likely to wilt. Full harvest should be done just before plants start to flower. Cut the entire plant 4–6" above ground to promote a second growth. Leaves are easily bruised when picking, so handle carefully. Do not store at temperatures less than 50°F/10°C.

0829A - **Thai Basil** (*Ocimum basilicum*)

With a spicy, anise-clove scent and robust flavor, this fragrant basil is most commonly used in Thai or Vietnamese cooking. These attractive plants with medium-green leaves, purple stems, and dense purple blossoms produce lovely flowers that could also warrant this variety a place in the flower garden. The blossoms are irresistible to bees. Good for container gardening. Annual.

Direct Seed 1/8" Deep	Germination 5-30 Days	Thin 4-6" Apart	Light Full Sun
---------------------------------	---------------------------------	---------------------------	--------------------------

Instructions- Sow seeds outdoors when soil is warm and temperatures do not drop below 65°F. Can also be started indoors 4-6 weeks before planting out. Make successive sowings for continuous summer supply. Pinch back flower stalks as they appear to keep plants from bolting. Prefers rich, well-drained soil.



0280A - **Triple Curled Parsley**

(Petroselinum hortensis)

Closely curled dark-green leaves. Fast-growing, uniform strain. High in vitamins and minerals. Holds for a long time at harvesting stage, even in warm weather. Biennial in zones 6-9, grown as an annual. 68-75 days.

Direct Seed 1/4" Deep	Germination 14-21 Days	Thin 6-12" Apart	Light Sun/Partial Shade
---------------------------------	----------------------------------	----------------------------	--------------------------------------

Instructions- Sow seeds outdoors just before last frost. Can also be started indoors and set out as small plants. Parsley seeds can be soaked in warm water for 24 hours before planting. Prefers full sun to partial shade and well-drained, rich soil.

The dark-green, toothed leaves of this mint species are used for making tea and cocktails and for flavoring candies and desserts, as well as for adding fragrance to lotions and tinctures. Perennial in zones 4-10.

Learn To Grow It

Start Indoors	Germination	Plant	Light
4-6 Weeks before last frost	7-10 Days	Outdoors 12-18" Apart	Sun/Partial Shade

Instructions- Sow seeds indoors just beneath surface of soil. Transplant outdoors after danger of frost has passed in late spring. Can also be directly sown outdoors just before last spring frost. Spearmint will spread vigorously; to control its runners, plant in a container sunk into ground. Prefers average, well-drained soil and will tolerate dry conditions.



BORAGE

Borago officinalis

LIFE CYCLE: Annual.

DAYS TO HARVEST: 50–60 days.

CULTURE: Easy to grow. Borage readily self-sows.

Direct seed (recommended) – Sow seeds as soon as soil has warmed in the spring. Plant $\frac{1}{4}$ – $\frac{1}{2}$ " deep, 3 seeds per foot, in rows that are 24" apart. Thin to 12" spacing for individual plants.

Transplant – Indoor planting is possible, but not recommended as borage develops a taproot and is somewhat difficult to transplant.

GERMINATION: 7–14 days.

LIGHT/SOIL REQUIREMENTS: Does well in average soil, and will do well even in poor soils, in full sun.

HEIGHT: 18–30".

HARVEST: Harvest borage as it begins to flower. Dry flowers quickly under moderate heat with good air circulation.

GARLIC CHIVES

1244A - **Garlic Chives** (*Allium tuberosum*)

A relative of standard culinary chives, this species produces beautiful, white, star-shaped flower clusters that adorn the garden in late August as well as mild, garlic-flavored, flattened leaves that can be harvested through the season for cooking and adding to salads, or for topping baked potatoes. Its beautiful flowers are edible as well. Perennial in zones 4-8.

Learn To Grow It


Start Indoors	Germination	Plant	Light
4-6 Weeks before last frost	7-14 Days	Outdoors 4-8" Apart	Sun/Partial Shade

Instructions- Chives are easy to direct sow. Alternatively, seeds can be sown indoors ¼" deep and transplanted outdoors as soon as soil can be worked in spring. Established plants can easily be divided in both spring and fall. Trim chive plant down to 1" or 2" above ground when harvesting.

0192A - **Byrd Mustard** (*Brassica juncea*)

This variety's leaves have the classic spice and sharpness of a good mustard green, and are more substantial in texture than other leafy greens. The glossy, highly toothed leaves gently cascade downward, making them an attractive addition to the vegetable garden. Jim Tjepkema received the variety from Dorothy Jones in 1990 and later donated it to Seed Savers Exchange. The variety's lineage can be traced to Georgia in 1839, through Dorothy's husband's ancestors.

Learn To Grow It

Direct Sow
1/2" Deep

Germination
5-10 Days

Thin
12" Apart

Light
Full Sun

Instructions- Best planted as a cool-season crop in early spring or fall. For early-spring crop, sow seeds 4-6 weeks before the last frost. For fall crop, sow 4-6 weeks before the first frost. Plants can tolerate a light frost, which will make the leaves sweeter. Warm weather will make the leaves spicier.

STEVIA



Sweet, Naturally

0982 - **Stevia** (*Stevia rebaudiana*)

Nature's sweet secret. Stevia has been used in Japan since the 1970s, when the safety of artificial sweeteners was called into question. Its extracts are 200-300 times sweeter than sugar, virtually calorie-free, and all natural. This sub-tropical plant is grown as an annual and needs some protection when when temperatures fall below 50°F.

Learn To Grow It


Start Indoors	Germination	Plant	Light
8-12 Weeks before last frost	7-21 Days	Outdoors 8-12" Apart	Sun/Partial Shade

Instructions- Sow seeds indoors on surface of soil. Keep indoors until nighttime temperatures are consistently above 50°F; may then be transplanted outdoors or into pots. Prefers well-drained soil—do not overwater. Can be grown year-round in pots if given proper care.
